There was a discussion relating to individual tax benefits for the contribution. There was a request for a more open discussion for the Frequency Defense Fund in 2012. The proposal passed, with 1 dissenting vote, for donating \$500.

The floor was given to C. Barrows who spoke about the TERAC website and solicited ideas and directions.

D. Ballard volunteered to help C. Barrows with managing the email list.

There was a proposal to shorten the monthly email by omitting the newsletter and only providing an announcement and a link to the newsletter, which will be posted on the TERAC website. There was no objection to the proposal.
