Barrie Gilbert

Meeting Thursday, March 11th

***** Bring some of your own favorite tubes to brag about *****

Barrie Gilbert is probably best known for his 1967 invention of the circuit which is used as a mixer in any modern wireless device, and for the translinear principle; although, as he would say, "I have done several other things since then". He pursued an early interest in transistors at SRDE and later at Mullard Ltd, working on first-generation planar ICs while also designing two sampling oscilloscopes. Emigrating to the United States in 1964, he joined Tektronix, Beaverton, Oregon, where he proposed and developed the first fully-electronic knob-readout system for 'scopes and other advances. Back in England from 1970 to '72, he was Group Research Leader at Plessey Laboratories. He consulted for Analog Devices Inc. from 1972 to '77, and then returned to Tek for a couple of years. In 1979, Analog Devices agreed to Barrie

forming a remote center for IC design in Oregon, electing him as first ADI Fellow. He has five times received the ISSCC's "Outstanding Paper Award", and is the recipient of numerous IEEE and industry awards, including the IEEE "Outstanding Achievement Award" for work on super-integrated logic; the IEEE "Outstanding Development Award"; the SSC Council Award for his "Contributions to Nonlinear Signal Processing"; "Oregon Researcher of the Year"; Microwave magazine's "Legend" award, and other such wall decor, including an OSU Honorary Doctorate of Engineering. He was inducted as a Member of the U.S. National Academy of Engineering in 2009. Barrie has been issued over 80 patents.

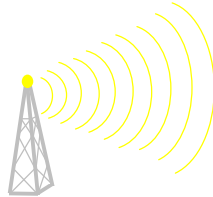
