Summits on the Air (SOTA) JD Fort, K7JDF and Dan Smith, KK7DS

SOTA is an award scheme for radio amateurs and shortwave listeners that encourages portable operation in mountainous areas. SOTA has been carefully designed to make participation possible for everyone - this is not just for mountaineers! There are awards for activators (those who ascend to the summits) and chasers (who either operate from home, a local hilltop or are even Activators on other summits).

SOTA is now fully operational in many countries across the world. Each country has its own Association which defines the recognised SOTA summits within that Association. Each summit earns the activators and chasers a score which is related to the height of the summit. Certificates are available for various scores, leading to the prestigious "Mountain Goat" and "Shack Sloth" trophies. An Honour Roll for Activators and Chasers is maintained at the SOTA online database.

JD Fort is the ARES station manager at K7HIO, the City of Hillsboro EOC. JD has had a career in commercial radio, being a DJ and a program manager at various radio stations in the Northwest. Currently, JD is a key individual at Buddipole. His hobbies include recreational firearms use, ham radio and hiking with his Golden Retriever Buddy. Dan is an extra-class amateur radio operator who enjoys many aspects of the hobby, especially digital modes and lately operating from mountain summits. He holds a Masters in Computer Science from North Carolina State University and works for IBM's Linux Technology Center in Beaverton.
