NASA's Space Tracking Network in Australia and the Moon landing

To support its space program, the USA established an extensive worldwide space tracking system. This presentation will discuss this network as it pertained to Australia and, using unique audio and video clips recorded at one of these stations, detail the preeminent role these facilities played during the moon landing. Of special interest will be clips of the late Neil Armstrong descending the ladder as only seen at the Honeysuckle Creek facility including Super 8 movie camera records of the activity at the station. Real time TV from the moon from three of the stations and from telemetry and videotape immediately afterwards. The start of the Apollo 11 Moonwalk as broadcast only in Australia. How "the first step" would have looked if the camera had not been tilted. Possibly the only surviving video of the dump of Apollo 11 backpacks after the Moonwalk. Gordon, W7NZL
